

## ***FRESHMAN COURSES - MUSIC MAJORS***

Here is the recommended course schedule for all freshman music majors. **SIGN UP FOR YOUR MUSIC CLASSES FIRST**, then add English and other core classes.

1. MUS-APL 10 - Concert Class	0 credits	
2. MUS 101 - Survey of Western Art Music	3 credits	(9:40 section) (10:40 section)
3. MUS 119 - Materials of Music OR (see your acceptance letter) MUS 103 – Elements of Music	3 credits  3 credits	(varies by section)  (various by section)
4. MUS 121 - Ear Training I (do not enroll if in Elements)	1 credit	(varies by section)
5. MUS-PRV xx2 - Private Lessons (2-credit sections <i>only</i> )	2 credits	(varies by teacher)
- Course number depends upon the student's major instrument/voice.		
- Schedule the lessons with the private teacher during the first week of classes.		
- <b>Do not</b> enroll in the 4-credit sections - these are reserved for returning and transfer students.		
Students desiring a performance major must audition before a faculty jury in December.		
6. MUS-ENS 1xx - Music Ensemble	1 credit	(- Meistersingers) (- Symph. Winds) (- Marching Band) (- Orchestra)
- Vocal/keyboard/guitar majors should sign up for Meistersingers (MUS-ENS 105). There will be an audition for this group. Those not accepted into Meistersingers will sign up for University Singers.		
- Woodwind/Brass/Percussion majors should sign up for Symphonic Winds (MUS-ENS 120). There will be an audition for this group. Those not accepted into Symphonic Winds will sign up for All-Campus Concert Band.		
- String majors should sign up for Orchestra (MUS-ENS 150). Note this groups meets T/TH plus M.		
7. MUS-APL 108 - Class Piano I	1 credit	(varies by section)
8. ENGL 101- English Composition (honors section if qualified)	3 credits	(varies by section)

### ***ADDITIONS TO THIS BASIC SCHEDULE:***

- Woodwind/Brass/Percussion majors should also add MUS-ENS 121(Marching Band), 1 credit, #71209 **IF** they want to march (some students may not). If they have a scholarship from the marching band, obviously they must register for this ensemble. Any student in marching band should not register for more than 15 credits due to the time commitment involved with this group.
- Students wishing more than 13 credits should add an Area I or II core class. However, there are very strict requirements for each major regarding which core classes are acceptable. Please contact an advisor before you sign up for one of these courses.
- There are other small ensembles available, such as Jazz Band, Flute Choir, Trombone Choir, Tuba/Euphonium Ensemble, Percussion Ensemble, and various brass/woodwind/string ensembles, that may be taken with permission of the conductor or your private teacher.
