### TECHNICAL NOTES

- Data reflect the specified bachelor's degree-seeking cohorts, 10th day. Starting in Fall 2012, official cohorts are based on the October 15 census. Cohort headcount and associated calculations have been adjusted to account for Federally allowable exclusions -- military service, missions, permanent disability, or death. These data are refreshed annually and, because of additional exclusions, the totals may vary slightly from what is reported to IPEDS. The sum of individual categories may not equal the overall total due to missing data or because certain categories apply to subsets

- Idaho Rural: Idaho Urban includes students whose permanent address at the time of application was in an "urbanized area or associated place" per the 2010 U.S. Census. Idaho Rural includes students who are from non-urban areas in Idaho. The Urban/Rural definitions were implemented in fall 2020. Data are available fall 2010 and forward; data presented prior to 2020 reflect a current version.

- IPEDS Ethnicity reflects race/ethnicity per Federal reporting requirements. Data presented prior to 2013 reflect a current version.

- First Generation denotes neither parent/guardian having completed a four year baccalaureate degree. Data are available fall 2015 and forward.

- Distance Ed. Program denotes the type of program in which students are enrolled. Fully online means the program is delivered online; blend reflects students who were enrolled in at least one campus-based program and one fully online program; campus-based includes students who were enrolled solely in a traditional program. Data are available fall 2016 and forward.
