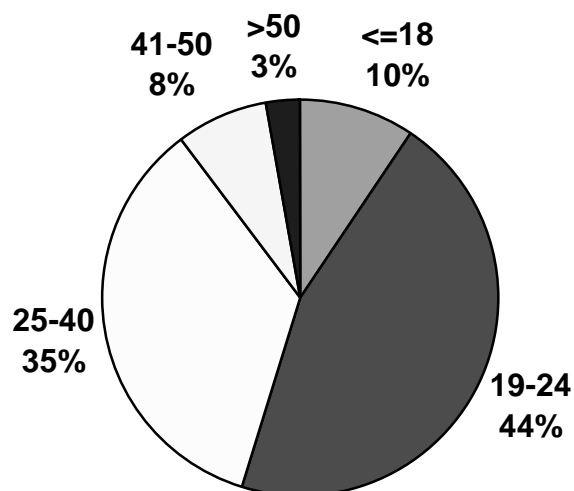

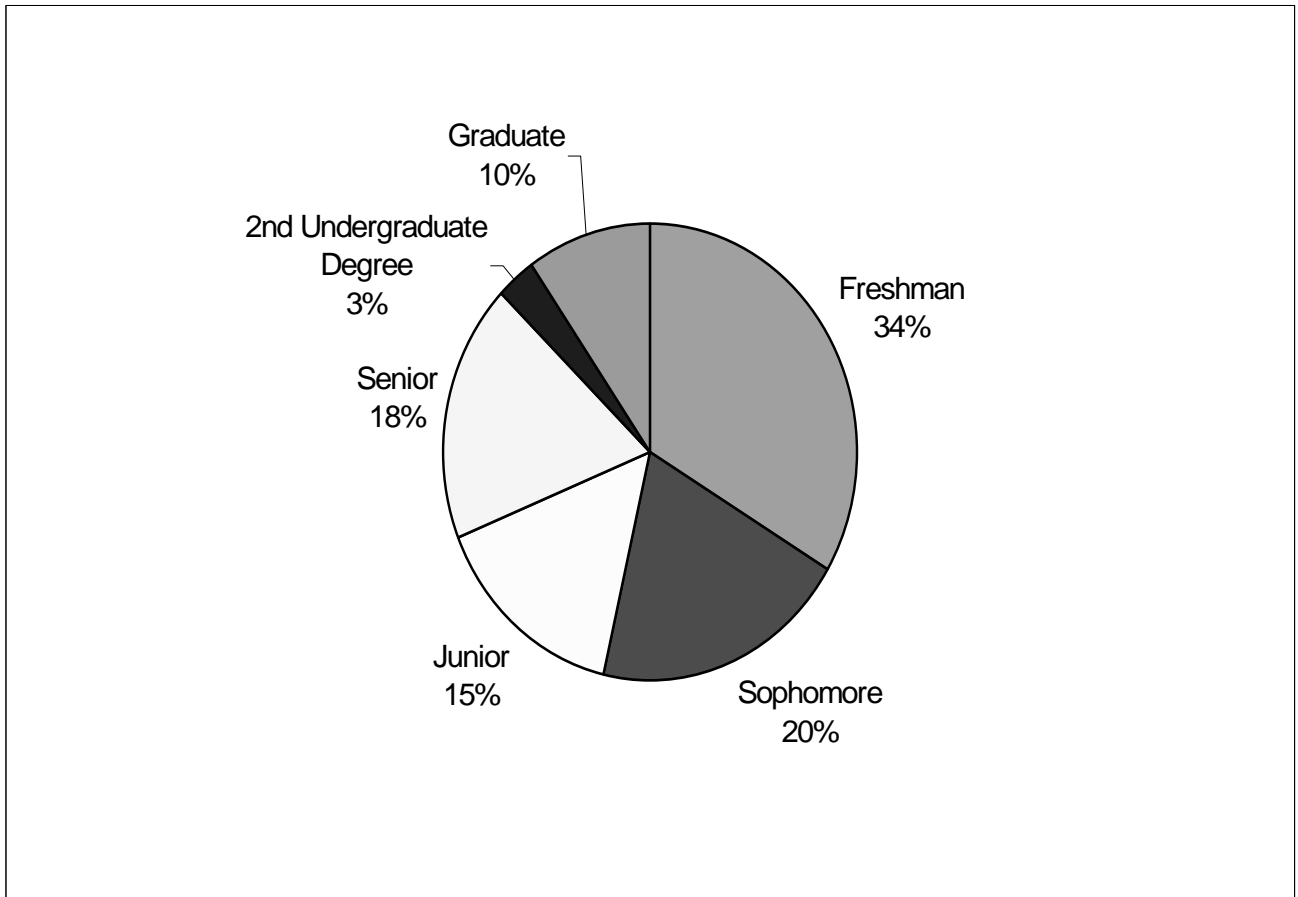

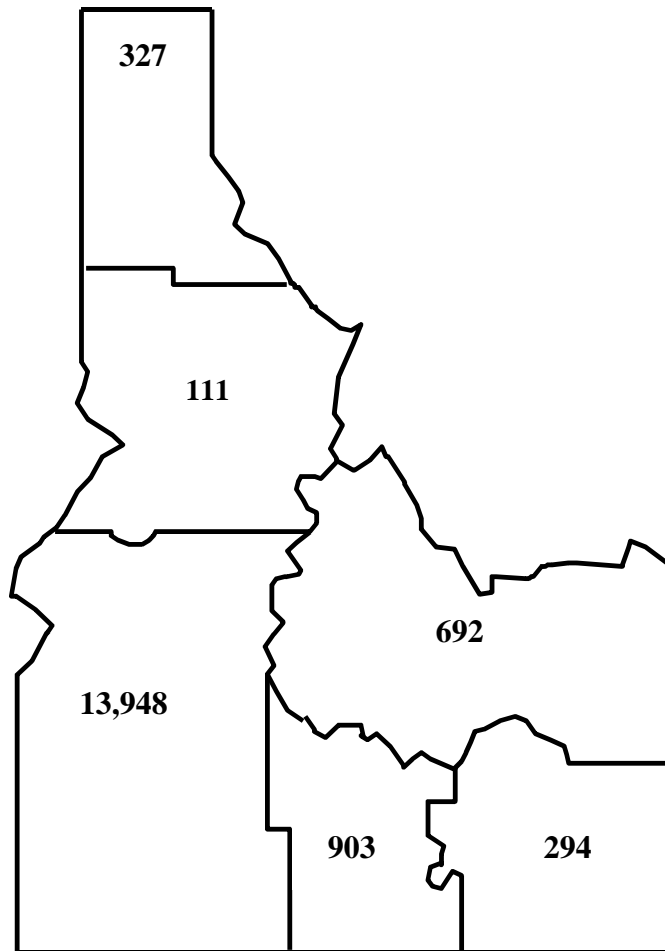

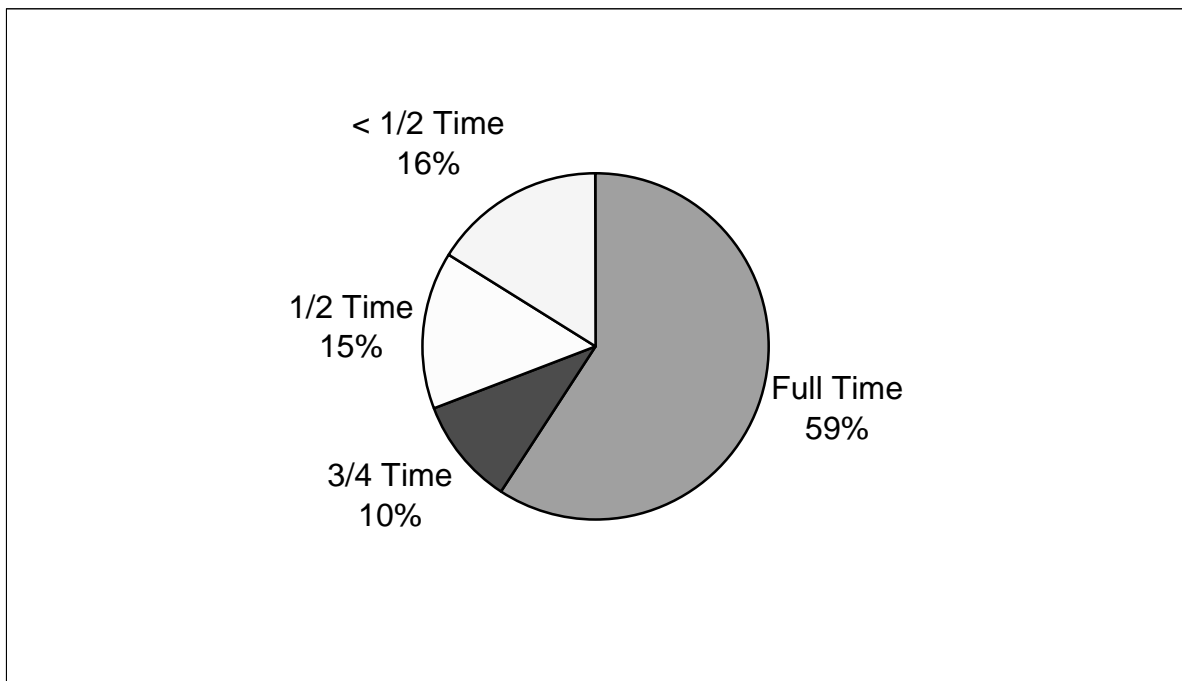
**Enrollment By Region of State**

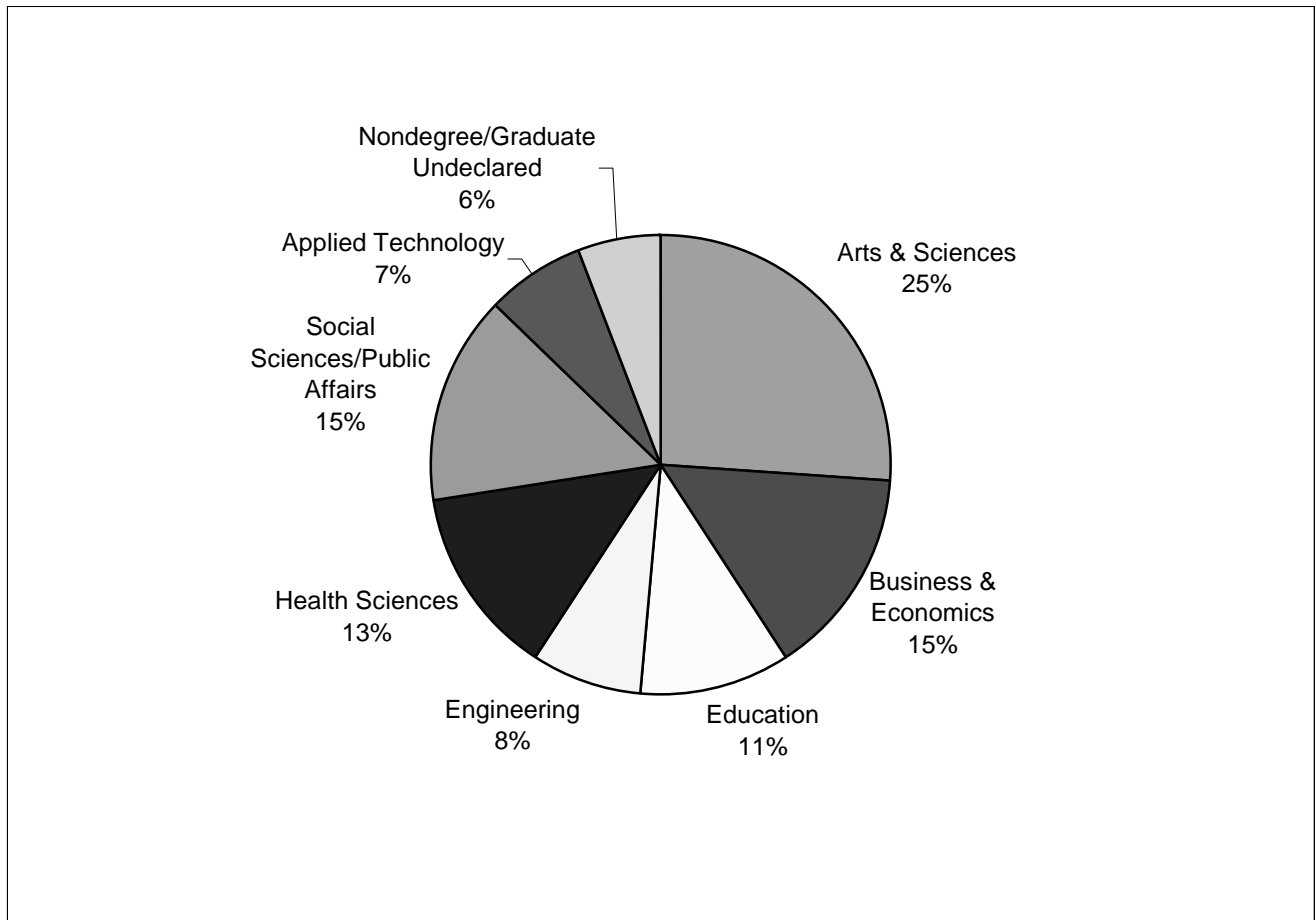
