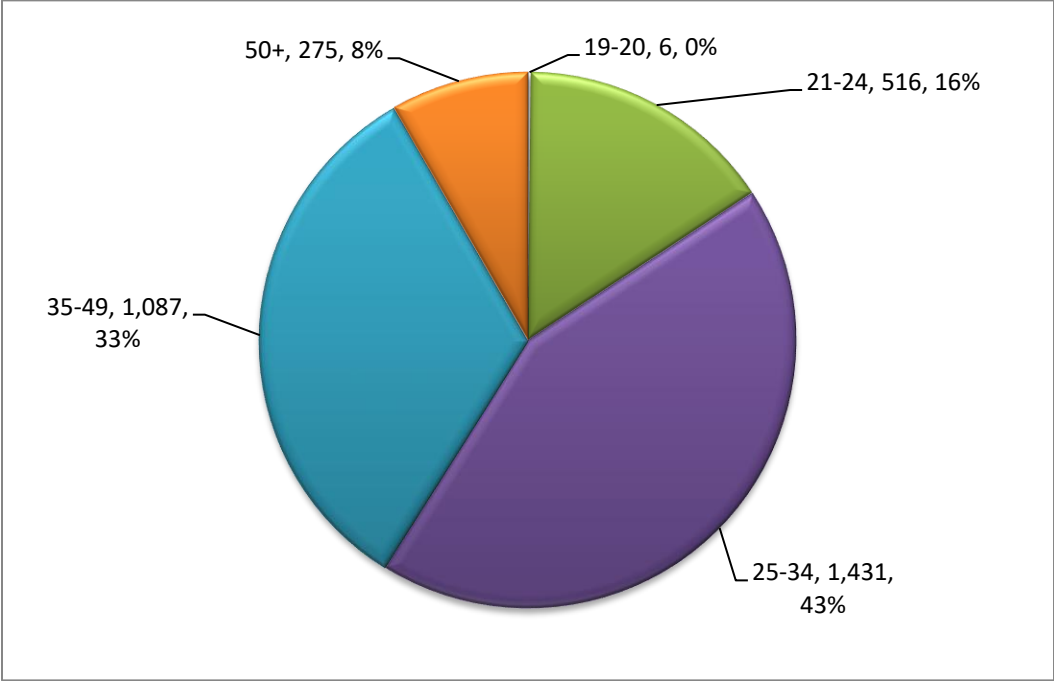

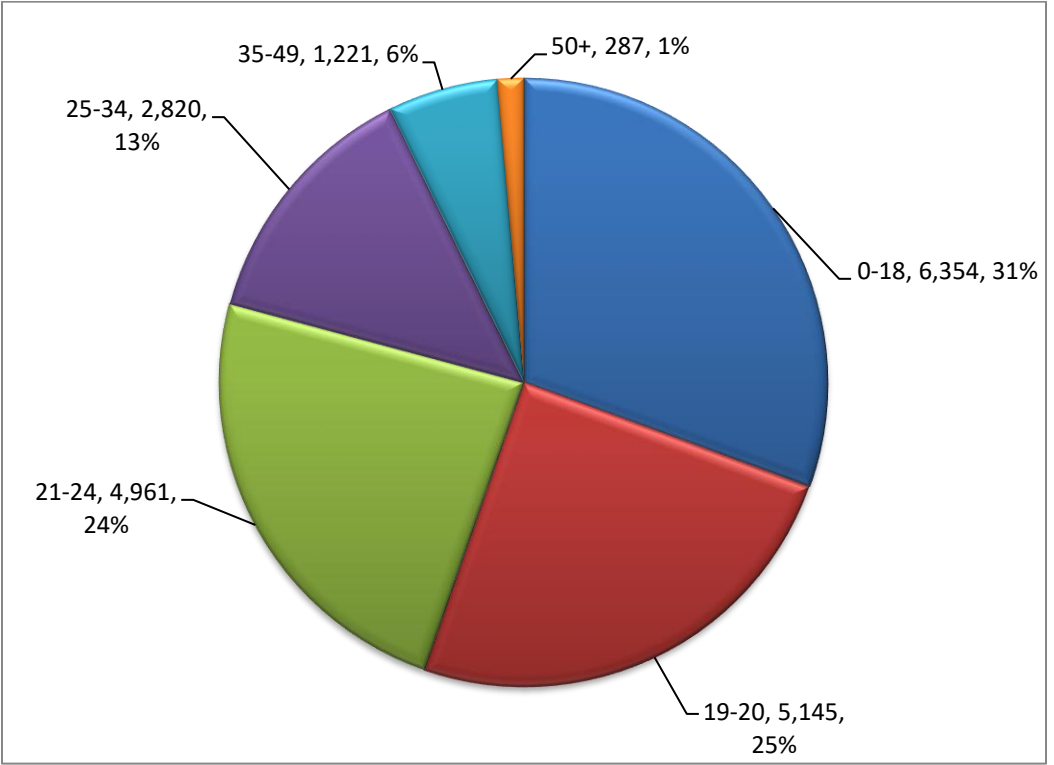

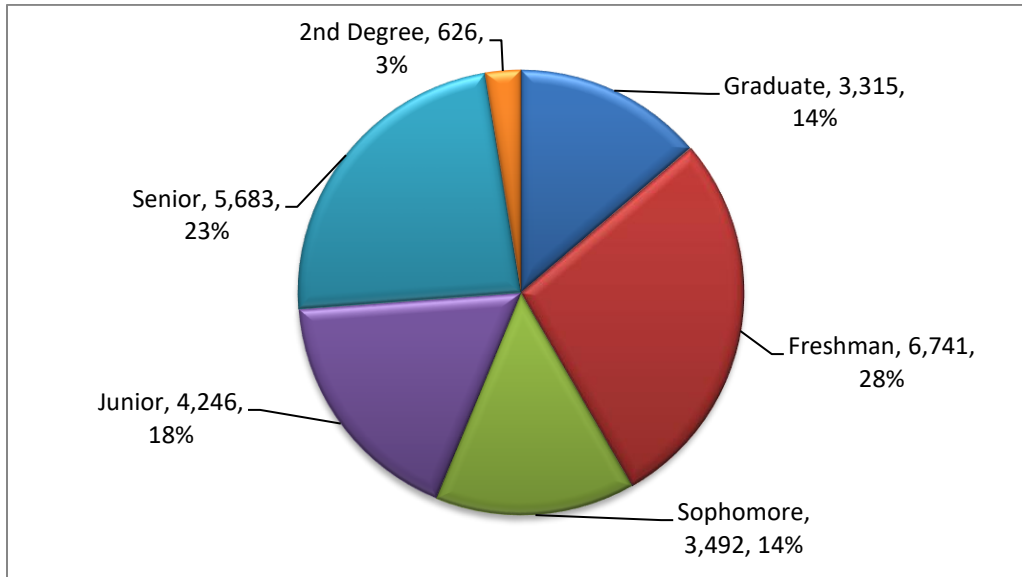
### Graduate Age Distribution

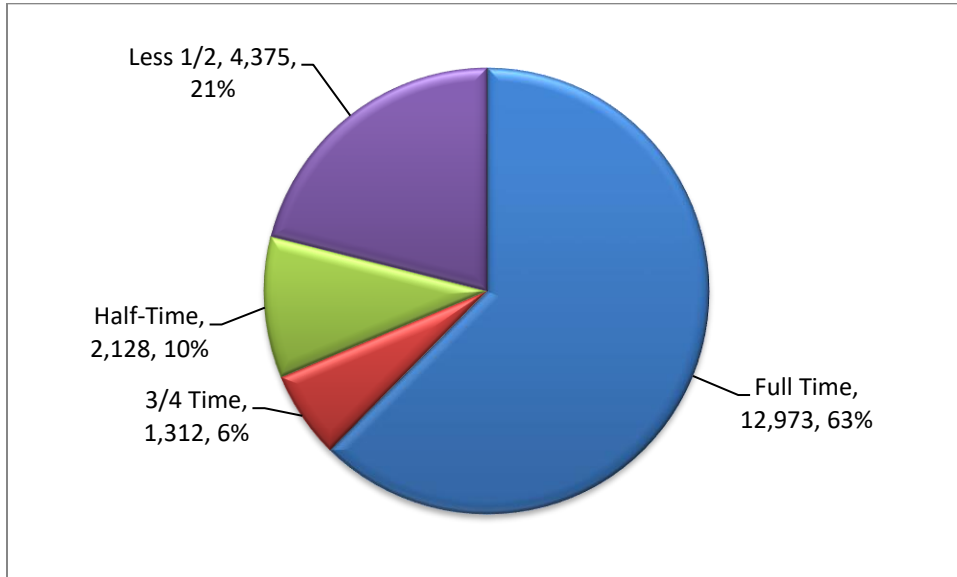

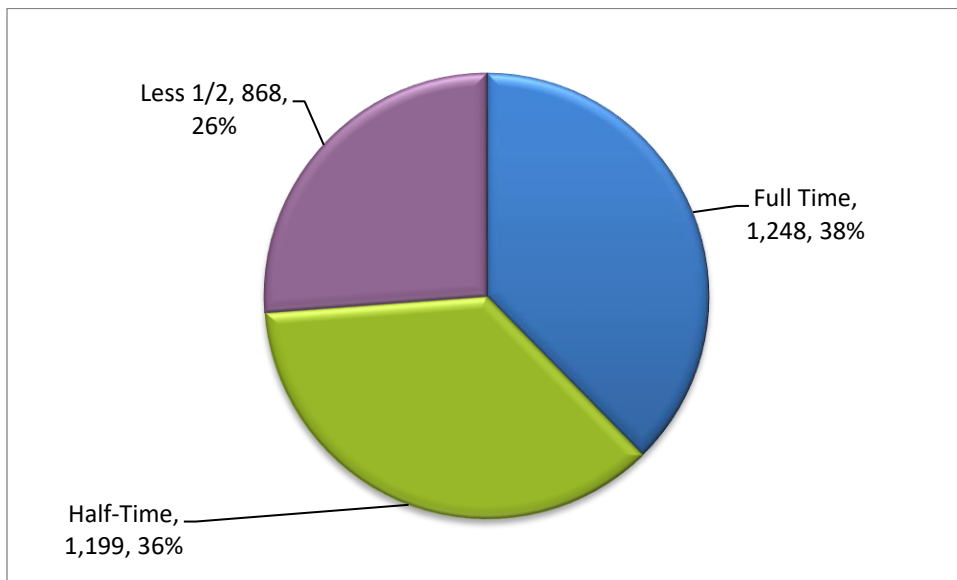
### Credit Load – Undergraduate

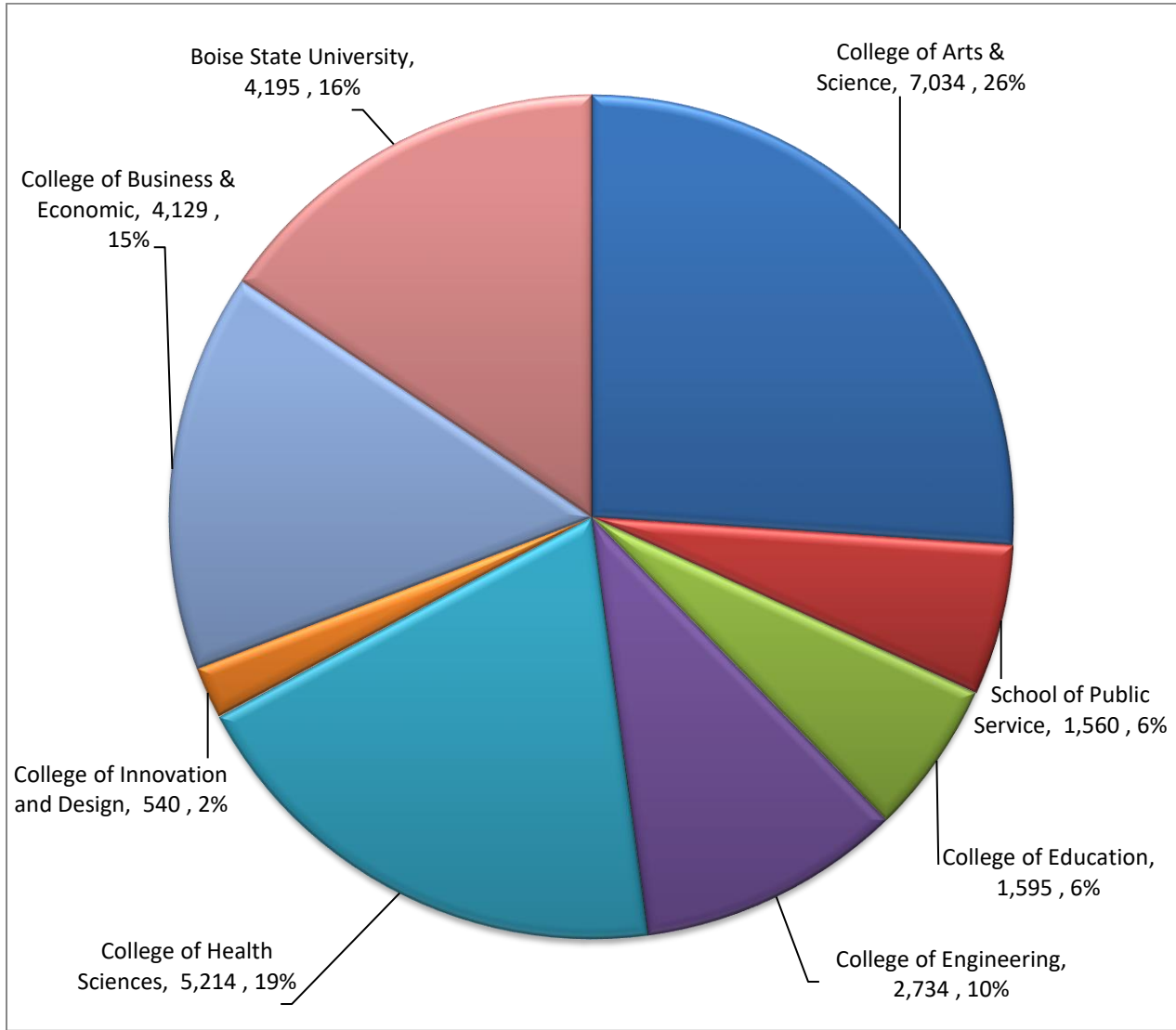
### Credit Load – Graduate
