

Total Undergraduate Applications for Spring 2024: 4,085

The Profile of New Enrolled Transfer Students is based on the transfer cohort model for enrolled students. The cohort captures first time, degree-seeking undergraduate students. Non-degree seeking, concurrent high school, bridge and second degree seeking students are excluded from the cohort. Application and admission numbers are based on admit type, not cohort. Application numbers include those from applicants who did not complete the application process and were not given an admission decision.

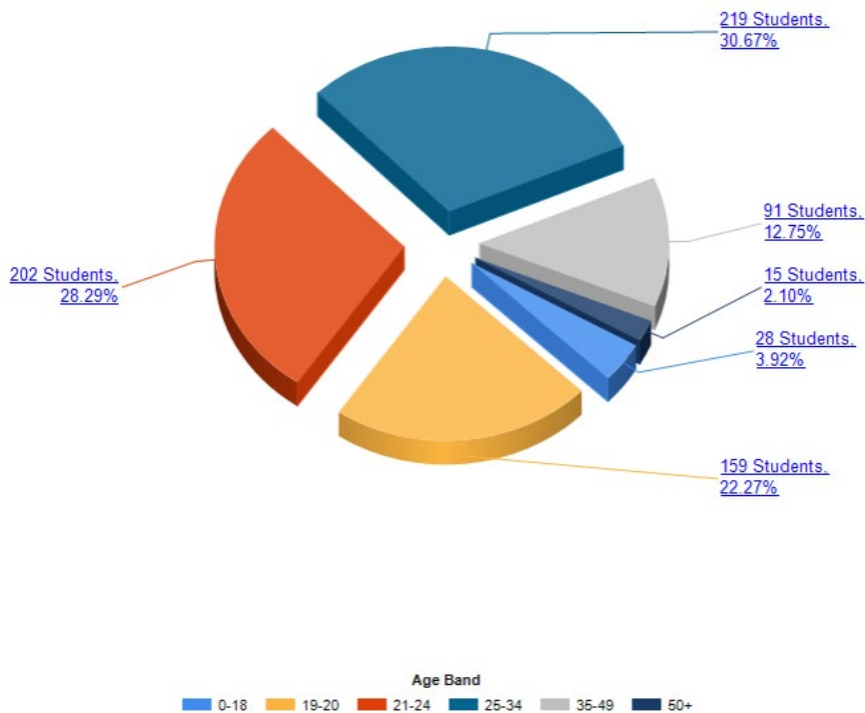


Figure 1- Age of New Transfer Students

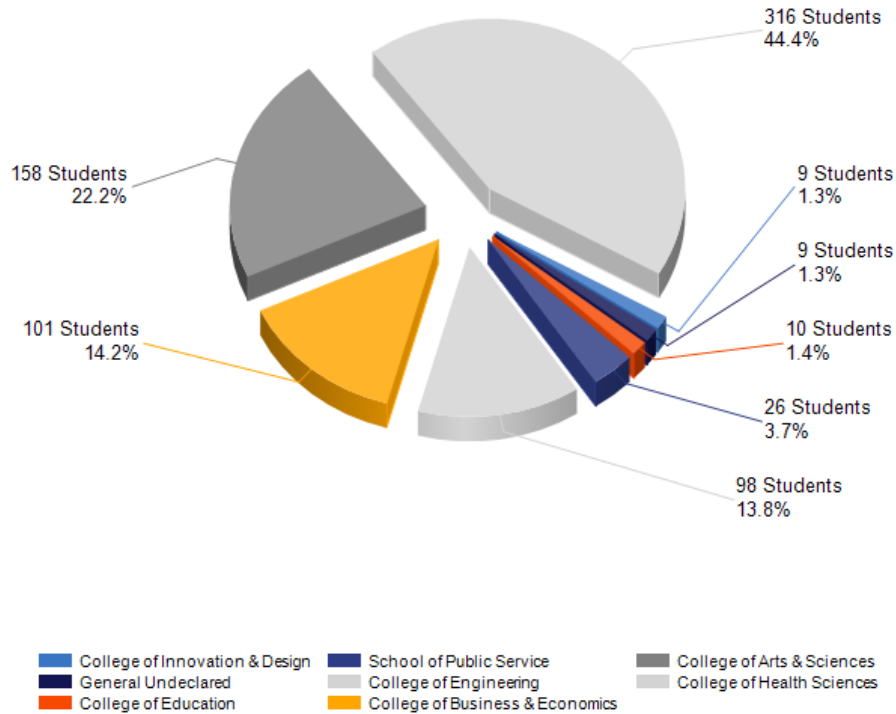


Figure 2 – College Majors of New Transfer Students

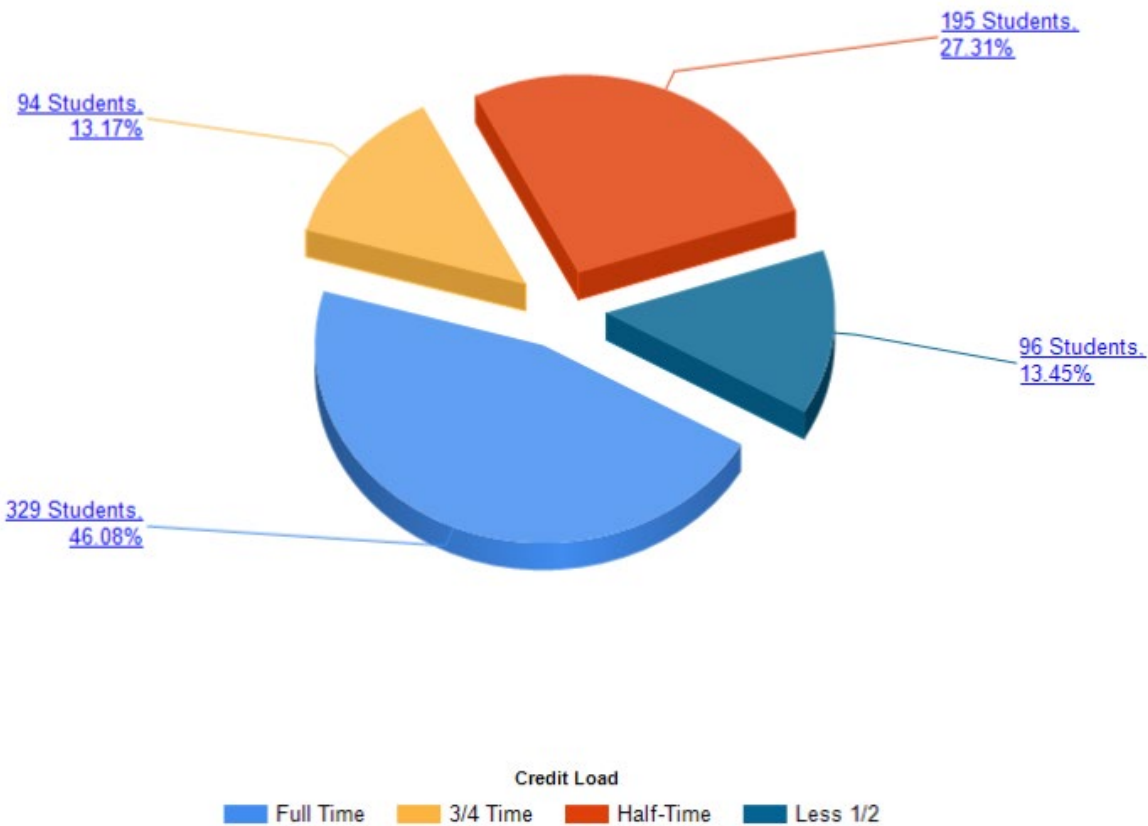


Figure 3 – Credit Load for New Transfer Students
