## MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Campus based scholarship

- 1. High School Seniors who are interested in receiving a campus based scholarship must complete their application packet no later than 1 August of each year to be considered for a scholarship. Scholarships turned in prior to the deadline will receive earlier consideration.
- 2. The following is a list of all required documents that must be present in each scholarship application.
  - a. Presidential Fitness Test results (reference physical fitness scorecard on BSU ROTC website)
  - b. Scholarship application available on BSU ROTC website (electronically completed is preferred)
  - c. Official High School Transcripts
  - d. ACT and SAT test results
  - e. Interview with Professor of Military Science (If a face to face interview is not possible, an alternative method for the interview may be established. Please contact Mr. Ryan Hansen to schedule all appointments 208-426-3500)
  - f. Applicants must be in compliance with Army height and weight standards (reference AR 600-9 on BSU ROTC website)
- 3. All campus based scholarships are four year or three year scholarships. Scholarship applicants must be prepared to pay for their freshman year of college on their own.
- 4. The number of scholarships awarded is dependent on the amount of funds available to the university and Department of Defense. There is no guarantee that any scholarships will be awarded.
- 5. It is preferred/requested that all documents be completed and submitted electronically to <a href="mailto:armyrotc@boisestate.edu">armyrotc@boisestate.edu</a>.
